

HOW TO START GIVING OUT THE GOSPEL

Give Out Gospel Tracts:

If you want to pick fruits you must plant seeds. Giving gospel tracts is one great way to plant seeds. They then have a chance to get saved.

Plant Seeds:

"A sower went forth to sow" Matt.13: 3. A farmer can have the most fertile field, the richest soil but he won't get any fruit until he plants seed. He could pray over it all day but he will get nothing but weeds until he plants seeds. So it is for spiritual sowers, Truth is that "the harvest in plenteous", tragedy is that "the laborers are few" and our world is going to hell on a slippery sled.

How to Plant Seeds:

Everyone cannot get in a pulpit and preach or get on the radio or get on Television but everyone can graciously, courteously hand a tract to that clerk, the cashier, the salesman, the waitress, the delivery man, the neighbour, co-student, colleague at work or that fellow workman.

Be Sure:

Never give out a tract you have not read yourself. Be sure it has the gospel, the good news that "Christ died for our sins, He was buried, rose again and was seen by hundreds" 1Cor.15: 1-4. These four points are so important to share. Over 50% of the tracts I have read carefully do not have the gospel in them. Remember this, "The gospel is the power of God unto salvation to everyone who believes" Romans 1: 16. — Sumner Wemps
