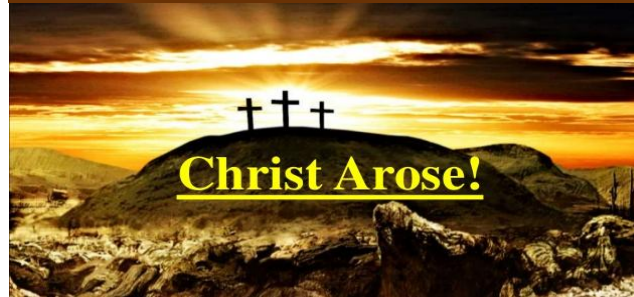

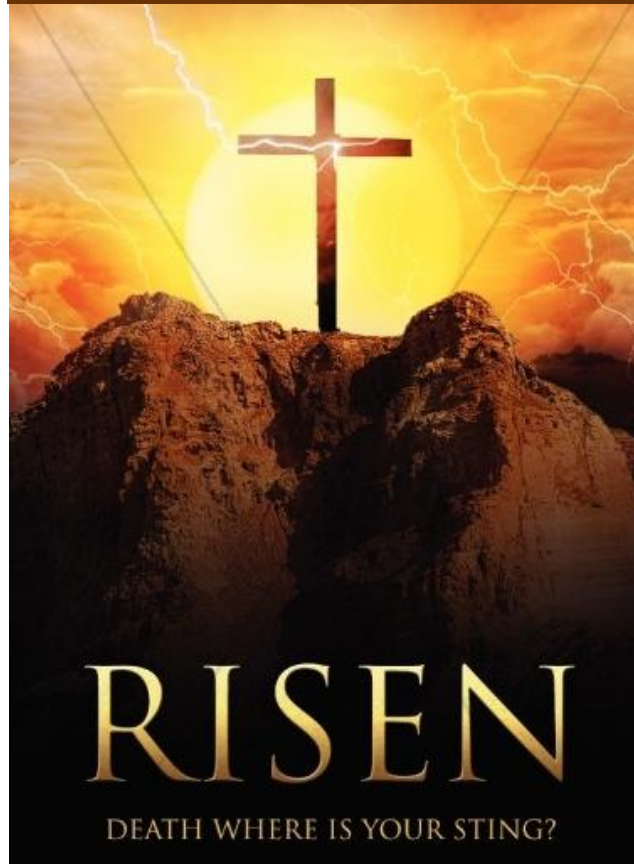

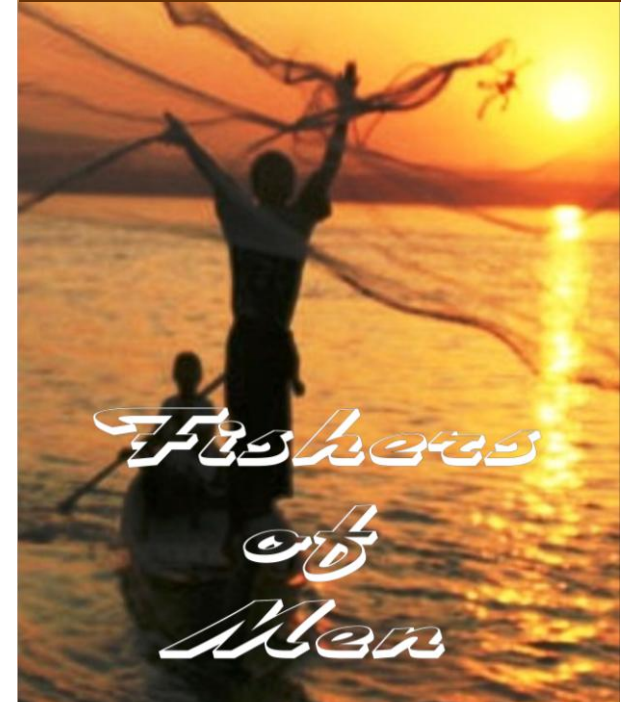

SALVATION THROUGH CHRIST

Although it cost Jesus everything to pay for your sins and mine, He makes it very easy for us to know Him personally and to be saved. We are the sinners; He is the sacrifice. We have the problem; He is the provider. Here is God's plan of salvation for you and me, according to the Bible.

First, admit that you are lost and need a Savior.

"For there is not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not." --Ecclesiastes 7: 20 "All have sinned, and come short of the glory of God." – Romans 3: 23

Second, realize that a heavy penalty is on your sin.

"Except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish." --Luke 13:3 "Wherefore, as by one man [Adam] sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned." – Romans 5: 12.

Third, acknowledge that God made a way for you to be saved.

"For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." --John 3: 16 "He humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross." – Philippians 2: 8.

Fourth, accept God's plan for your salvation today!

"He [Jesus] is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them." – Heb.7: 25 "But as many as received him [Jesus], to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name." – John 1: 12

Read the following prayer several times and then earnestly pray that prayer, accepting Christ personally, and God will forgive your sins and make you one of His own.

Dear Lord Jesus, I confess that I am a guilty sinner and that I need to be saved. I believe that Jesus died on the cross to pay my sin debt. Please forgive my sins, come into my heart, and save my soul. I turn my life over to You. Help me to live for You from now on. Amen.
