RAPTURE OF THE LIVING SAINTS

"Behold, I tell you a mystery; we will not all sleep, but we will all be changed." - 1Corinthians 15: 51.

Mystery but not mysterious: A mystery in Scripture is something that has been a secret or not known before but is revealed now.

We shall not all sleep: What an awesome announcement. Some of us will never die. Enoch and Elijah went to heaven without dying. All believers who are alive at the rapture, when Jesus comes, will go to heaven alive, without dying also.
