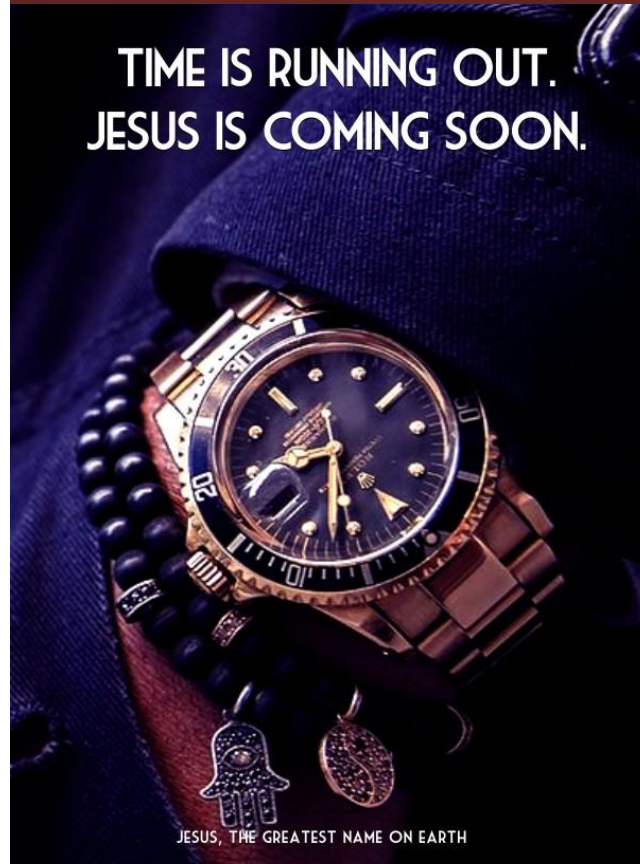

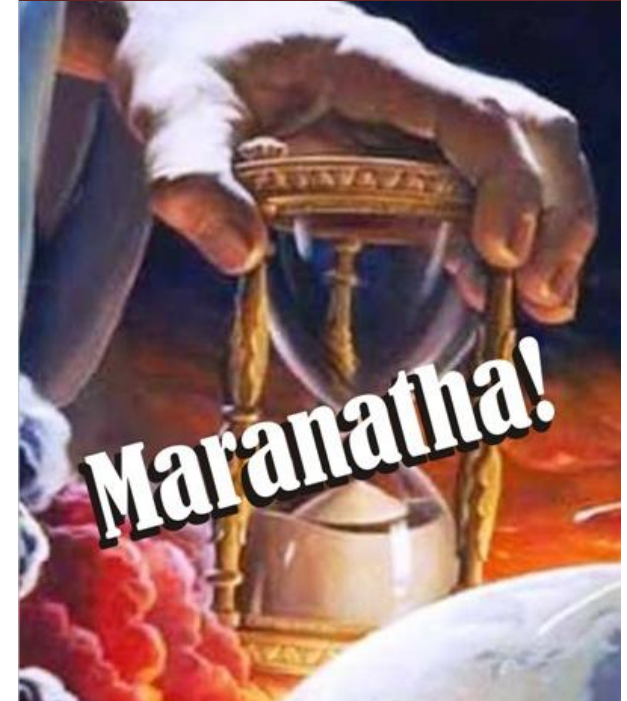

THE COMING TRIBULATION Corrie Ten Boom (1974)

As a little girl, I once went to my father and said, "Daddy, I am afraid that I will never be strong enough to be a martyr for Jesus Christ." "Tell me," said Father, "when you take a train trip, when do I give you the money for the ticket? Three weeks before?" "No, Daddy, you give me the money for the ticket just before we get on the train." "That is right," my father said, "and so it is with God. Our Heavenly Father knows when we'd need the strength to be a martyr for Jesus. He will supply all we need - only then."

My friends in the African church I visited nodded and smiled. Suddenly a spirit of joy descended upon that church and the people began singing, "In the sweet, by and by, we shall meet on that beautiful shore." Later that week, half the congregation of that church was executed. I heard later that the other half was killed some months ago. But I was so happy that the Lord used me to encourage these people with the word of God. The Bible says that Jesus not only overcome the world, but also promised that He would give a crown of life to all those who remained faithful to the end.

How can we prepare for the persecution? First we need to develop a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. Not just the Jesus of yesterday, the Jesus of History, but the life-changing Jesus of today who is still alive and sitting at the right hand of God. Next we need to feed on the word of God, digest it, and make it a part of our being. This will mean disciplined Bible study each day as we not only memorize long passages of scripture, but put the principles to work in our lives.

We must be filled with the Holy Spirit. This is not optional but absolutely necessary. Those earthly disciples could never have stood up under the persecution of the Jews and Romans had they not waited for Pentecost. We need our own personal Pentecost also, the baptism of the Holy Spirit. We will never be able to stand in the tribulation without it.

In the coming persecution we must be ready to help and encourage each other. But we must not wait until the tribulation comes before starting. The fruit of the Spirit should be the dominant force of every Christian's life now. No, you will not be strong in yourself when the tribulation comes. Rather, you will be strong in the power of Him who will never leave or forsake you
