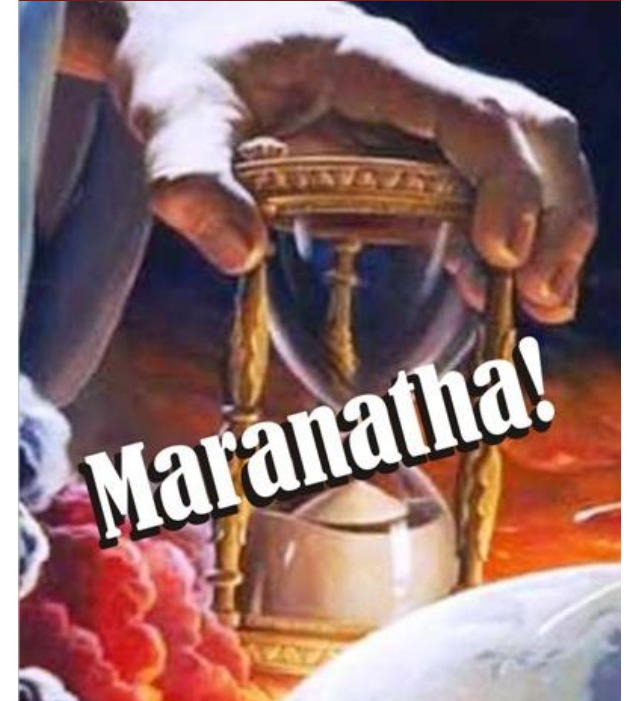

WHY CHRISTIANS ARE TROUBLED
