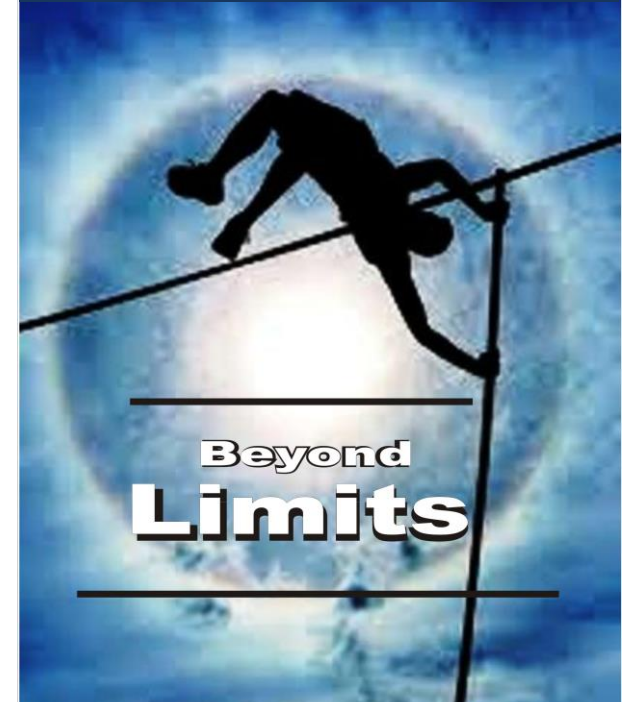

BEYOND LIMITS

"And now, behold, the LORD hath kept me alive, as He said, these forty and five years, even since the LORD spake this word unto Moses, while the children of Israel wandered in the wilderness: and now, lo, I am this day fourscore and five years old. As yet I am as strong this day as I was in the day that Moses sent me: as my strength was then, even so is my strength now, for war, both to go, and to come in. No therefore give me this mountain, whereof the LORD spake in that day, for thou heardest in that day how the Anakims were there, and that the cities were great and fenced: if so be the LORD will be with me, then I shall be able to drive them out, as the LORD said. And Joshua blessed him, and gave unto Caleb the son of Jephuneh Hebron for an inheritance." - Joshua 14: 10-13

God's promise to Caleb was very clear that he and Joshua would lead the Israelites to inherit Canaan, the Land of Promise. God's promises to us are clear too and lots of them are well stated in His Word e.g. Ps.34: 10 & 19; Jer.29: 11; Lk.10: 18-19; Rom.8: 28, etc.

Not even death can limit God's promise, plan and purpose for His children as we can see expressed in the life of Samuel who prophesied as a dead man and it came to pass, Elisha whose bones in the grave brought a dead man back to life and much more importantly our Lord Jesus Christ whose death and resurrection worked out the salvation of mankind eventually.

Caleb knew God's promise for him and he was bold and courageous enough both to claim it and assert himself in it. He was 85 years old when he took up the challenge to possess the mountain God gave him. He was unstoppable and beyond limits! We too can be unstoppable and beyond limits like Caleb but why are we not?

For us to move beyond limits, we must do away with all forms of excuses and anything that can debar us from reaching God's glorious heights in life. Such hindrances include sin, ignorance, unwillingness, lack of interest, desire or ambition, distraction, discouragement as well as lack of patience, persistence and endurance. If Caleb could do it, we can do it also. God bless.
