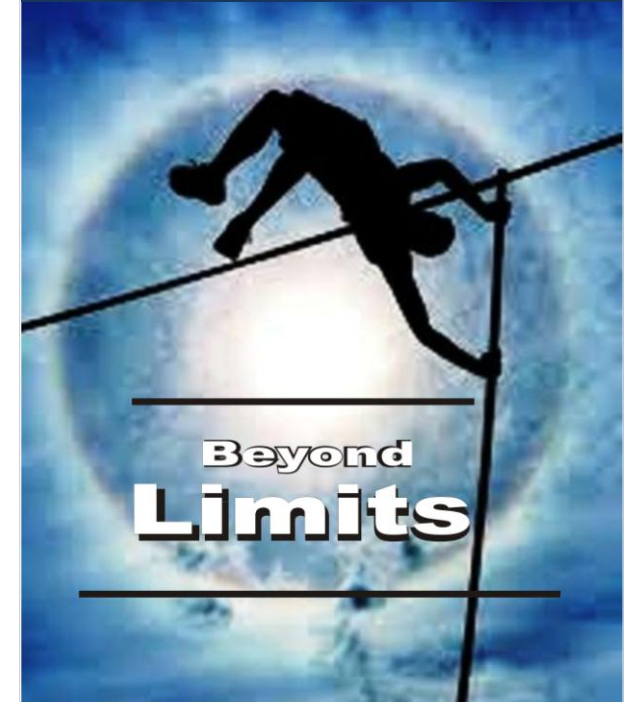

BEYOND LIMITS - 2

To be beyond limits, you must...

1. Belong to Jesus – Dan.11: 32; Jn.3: 3; 1: 2; Rom.8: 28.
2. Delight in His presence – Ps.122: 1; 23: 6. Jesus will separate and send the (mixed) multitudes away eventually e.g. Sheep and Goats in Matt.25.
3. Enjoy talking with God in prayer - Lk.18: 1; 1Thess.5: 17
4. Know His word very well. He will only back up what He commands and that is backed up by His word.
5. Go before the Lord – i. Always walk before His watchful eyes ii. Walk in the light of His word and be guided by it – Ps.119: 105 and, iii. Be covered always in His prayers. Jesus prayed and is still praying for you – Heb.7: 25.
6. Overcome fear and have faith in God - Jn.16: 33; Heb.11: 6; 1Jn.4: 4.
7. Be conscious of God's ever-abiding presence - Ps.23: 4.
8. Do not confuse God's presence for that of the Devil – 1Jn.4: 1-3 e. g. Joseph and Job. Life is a combination of Good & Bad, Ups & Downs; Sweets & Bitters, etc.
9. Hear God clearly and recognize His voice – Jn.10: 1-5, 27; Rom.8: 14.
10. Surrender and totally yield yourself to God – Rom.12: 1.
11. Believe that you can do what He did – Jn.14: 12.
12. Take up challenges and take risks for God – Mk.8: 34-38; 1Cor.15: 30-31; Rev.12; 11. Always try like Caleb in Josh.14. Better try and fail than never try at all!
13. Be bold and courageous to take action like Peter and Caleb – Josh.1: 3-7; 2Tim.1: 6-7; Jam.2: 20 & 26.
14. Do not panic in the storm – Ps.62:1-2; 1Pet.5: 7.
15. Be focused. Avoid distractions – physical, human and circumstantial distractions – Heb.12: 2.
16. Never give up when you try and fail. Failure is never final! – Lk.18: 1. Never give up when you succeed too. Your success is just starting – 1Cor.10: 12 e.g. Elijah.
17. Cry out to God for help. Don't be too quick to call for man's help. Vain is the help of man – Ps.121; 1; Jer.2: 13; Ps.60: 11; 108: 12.
18. Cry for help early before it's too late – Ps.63: 1; Isa.55: 6.
19. Do not resent or be afraid of corrections and rebukes – Prov.3: 11; Heb.12: 5-7.
20. Overcome your pride and humble yourself – Prov.16: 18; Jam.4: 10; 1Pet.5: 6.
