ATTITUDES FOR DIVINE LIFTING

Promotion comes only from God – **Psalm 75: 6-7**. But not everyone is promoted or experiences divine lifting. So, it is important for us to understand the factors influencing divine lifting and cultivate the right attitudes in order to experience it. We should learn from the life of the Lord Jesus Christ.

1. Self-denial: We need to empty ourselves totally before God irrespective of whatever we have or have acquired in life. It is important to have a high position or good reputation but we must not allow this come between us and God. We must all come like little children before God (Matt.18: 2-4). We are all '*Nobody*' before God! We must not be full of self but strip ourselves of all titles, honour and rightful privileges men accord us before God. Self-denial is to make no reputation of ourselves. Like Christ, we must make no reputation of ourselves.

2. Servant-hood: A bondservant (like Christ) is a person who is bound to serve without pay or wages. This is the right disposition or attitude God wants us to have in order to enjoy divine lifting. Money must not be the motivation for our service as Christians rather we should seek to be a blessing, edify the saints and glorify God (**Matt.10: 8; Ps.62: 10**). We must learn from the sins of Gehazi, Judas and Simon, the sorcerer. Eventually, it is only those who learn to live by faith and 'lose their lives' by taking sure risks for Christ that shall be lifted and gain their lives back (Matt.16: 25). Those who put money as their number one priority don't usually put in their best in service and so always disqualify themselves for promotion or elevation.

3. Humility: Humility is an important attitude for divine lifting. Jesus said, *"Whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted" (Matt.23:12).* The humble will always enjoy favour from God and their masters – (**Prov.3: 34).** Humility makes us teachable and fit for promotion (**Ps.25: 9**). Whereas, God lifts up the humble in spirit, He demotes or casts down those who are proud and haughty in spirit (**Ps.147: 6; Prov.16: 18; Jam.4: 6**). Humility is being like Christ (**Matt.11: 29**). Without any doubts, we need humility in order to be lifted by God, to sustain our present divine lifting and also to continue to enjoy more and more lifting in the future.

Obedience: Our Lord Jesus Christ obeyed even unto the death of the cross, which was the most shameful death of their time and God exalted Him. Obedience is a sure way of provoking God's favour upon your life. Abraham obeyed God's instructions and God's sworn blessings came on him and his descendants (Gen.12:1-4). When you obey God even when it is not convenient and it seems unreasonable, you position yourself for divine lifting. One thing is sure, the Lord who knows the end from the beginning, will never ask you to do what you cannot do and what will not be beneficial to you at the end.

In conclusion, when you embrace these fundamental components divine promotion of a lifetime will be your portion. Like Jesus Christ and many others, God will exalt you and release His blessings upon your life. Hymn 1
