NEW ANOINTING - 1

It is common now to anoint almost everything with oil but the oil is only a symbol of the anointing of the Holy Spirit; it is not the Holy Spirit Himself. Take note that there are other symbols of the Holy Spirit also e.g. Wind, Dove, Fire, etc.

The Holy Spirit is a person and not an object or a mere symbol. He is the 3rd Person of the Godhead or Trinity - **Jn.6: 7-14.**

God has always anointed men in previous dispensations as kings, priests and prophets but only does it now in greater dimension and magnitude - **Joel 2: 28-29; 1Pet.2: 9; Rev.1: 6.**

The anointing makes the power and abilities of the Almighty God available to us - mere mortal and finite men to take us beyond our natural abilities, wisdom and strength.

We all surely need God's anointing but we must understand the purpose.

God's anointing empowers us for ministry! Ministry is simply an assignment given by God. It goes beyond positions or titles; it is service and being a blessing to men as a gift from God. So, anointing helps us carry out our ministry and makes us a blessing to men!

One common ministry God has given all of us is **EVANGELISM (Matt.28: 18-20; Acts 1: 8)** and we can carry it out **EVERYWHERE!** Please, be committed to evangelism this year.
