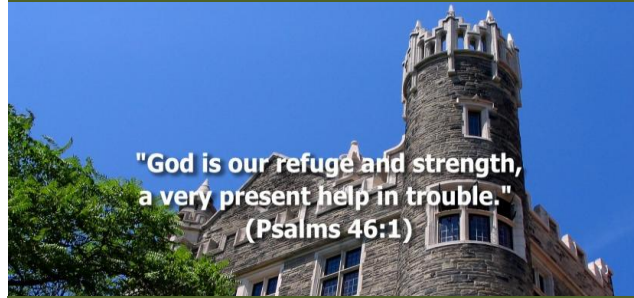

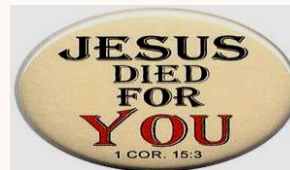

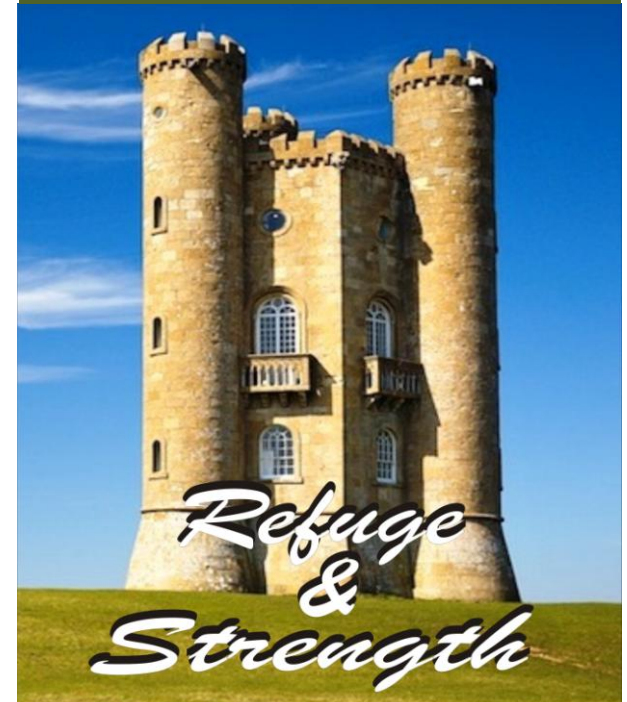

LOCKED OUT - Jim Kraus

We often take our home for granted - until we can no longer get inside. I know this from firsthand experience. I walk our family's dog twice a day - as much for my benefit as his. I get time outside to think, to get a little exercise, to be alone. The dog gets to smell almost every blade of grass in the neighbourhood.

One night, we took our evening stroll later than usual - around 11pm. I had been up reading and the rest of the family was long asleep. It was 11:30 when we returned. I punched in the code on the garage door opener. Nothing happened. I tried again. Nothing! I never carry a door key at night - I always enter by the garage. I tried again, carefully entering the numbers. No action at all. By this time, the dog appeared nervous. All the other doors of the house were locked, of course. I hesitated to ring the doorbell and wake someone up. Since it was close to midnight, I knew that no one would be eager to investigate.

Safety and comfort were less than a few inches away. I was totally and completely separated from my home. I tried the code once more - and the door finally rolled open. Both of us were relieved to be inside, in the safety and comfort of home.

The Scriptures relate a similar story of a man separated from his spiritual home. Psalms 61:1-4 (NIV) "Hear my cry, O God; listen to my prayer. From the ends of the earth I call to you, I call as my heart grows faint; lead me to the rock that is higher than I. For you have been my refuge, a strong tower against the foe. I long to dwell in your tent forever and take refuge in the shelter of your wings. Selah". The Psalms repeatedly refer to God as a refuge, a shelter and a place of safety.

The reality, however is that sin has disrupted our relationship, and we find ourselves far from home. But Jesus, by His death on the cross, has made a way back to God for us. He has provided a way to open the door. Romans 5:1-2 (NIV) "Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we rejoice in the hope of the glory of God".

Everyone who accepts Him as personal Saviour finds "the way, the truth and the life. No one can come to the Father except through Jesus." Jesus promise of a home extends beyond this life to the next. John 3: 16 (NIV) "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life". Allow Jesus to open the gift. Please, come home.
