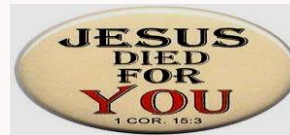

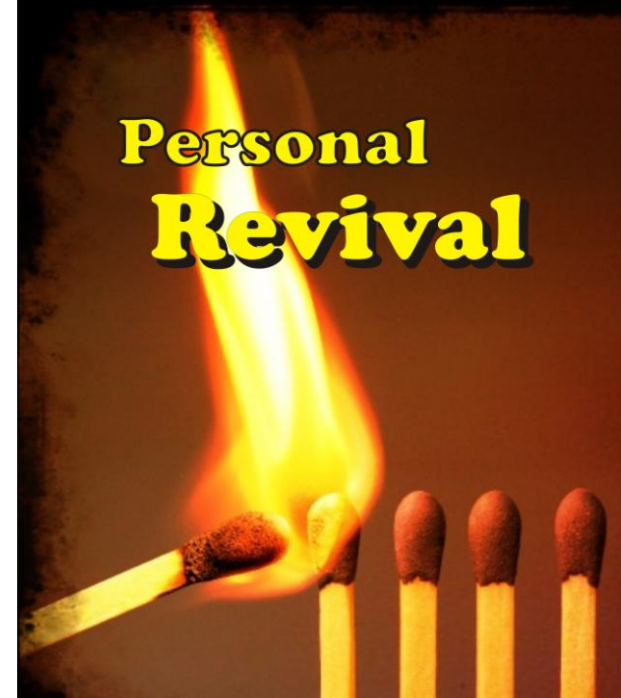

WHAT CAN ONE MAN DO?

The book of Jonah is a story of God sending one man to his greatest enemies the Syrians living in what Jonah describes as an enormous city that took three days to walk across, "Now Nineveh was an exceedingly great city, a three-day journey in extent..." - Jonah 3: 3. It really doesn't matter the exact size of Nineveh... suffice to say it was enormous, with a huge population! "And should I not pity Nineveh, that great city, in which are more than one hundred and twenty thousand persons who cannot discern between their right hand and their left-and much livestock?" - Jonah 4: 11.

It must have taken great courage in the end for Jonah to do God's will. But God gave him the strength... It is fitting at this point to recall what Jesus said about the only sign that would be given to an evil world, was the sign of Jonah who spent three days and three nights in the belly of a fish. "For as Jonah became a sign to the Ninevites, so also the Son of Man will be to this generation" - Luke 11: 30. Jesus was three days and three nights in the bowels of the earth and resurrected by God; like Jonah's 'resurrection' from the bowels of the fish. Jesus too was reluctant to go to Calvary and sweated blood in Gethsemane, and asked God if there was no other way saying, "Father, if it is Your will, take this cup away from Me; nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be done." Luke 22: 42. But unlike Jonah, Jesus did the will of God without running away.

Jonah gave the Ninevites the message "Yet forty days, and Nineveh shall be overthrown!" Jesus brought a similar message to the Jews, but they did not heed the Word and in 40 years Jerusalem lay waste. And Jesus said to them, "Do you not see all these things? Assuredly, I say to you, not one stone shall be left here upon another, that shall not be thrown down." - Matthew 24: 2. He said, "The men of Nineveh will rise up in the judgment with this generation and condemn it, because they repented at the preaching of Jonah; and indeed a greater than Jonah is here... (And they did not listen to His preaching)" - Matthew 12: 41.

In conclusion "What can one man do to change things in a mighty way"? BE OBEDIENT... SIMPLY BE OBEDIENT. If you think God is calling you in these last days please dear friend. Listen, pray about it and do it. Remember well the words of Isaiah, "Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying: "Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us?" Then I said, "Here am I! Send me." - Isaiah 6: 8. There is no better time than right now to spread the Gospel; why not do it?
