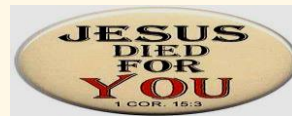

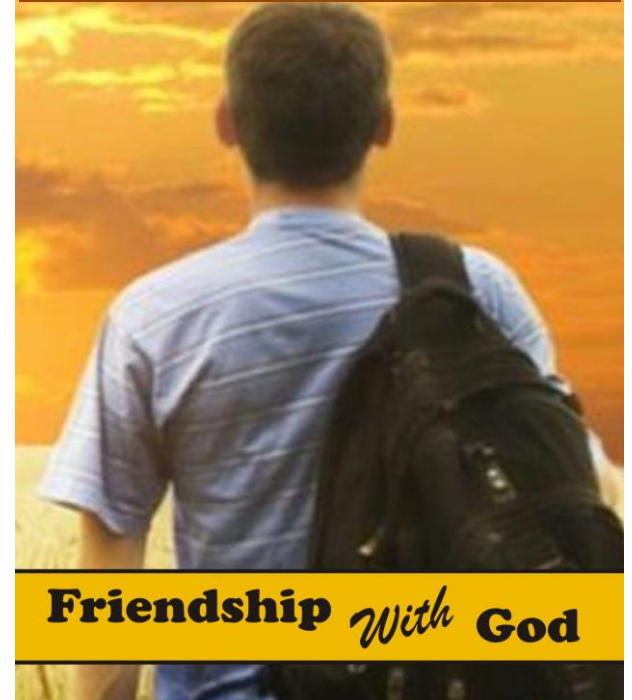

TRUTH IS A FRIEND - Crawford Loritts

The other evening I got a little angry with my wife, Karen. Now, although I don't carry a big sign that says, "Criticize me," I don't consider myself particularly sensitive to criticism. But, that evening Karen was telling me something that was true, and it was a subject I was a bit sensitive about. She didn't mean to upset me, but I got a little angry. Then later on, when it dawned on me that my reaction was not right, I had to apologize. She just was telling me the truth. She wanted to help me.

If we don't learn how to welcome and handle the truth, we'll never grow. The truth, although painful, should always be the guest of honour in our lives.

There's a very important lesson in Galatians 4: 15-16 about how to receive the truth and not discount the messenger. It says, "Where then is that sense of blessing you had? For I bear you witness that, if possible, you would have plucked out your eyes and given them to me. So have I become your enemy by telling you the truth?"

There are some important things we need to learn from this passage. First of all, don't surround yourself with people who will tell you only what you want to hear. You won't grow. They'll just solidify you in your state. They'll just affirm you and confirm you with all that is wrong with you. Secondly, we sometimes reject the messenger because we don't want to change. We say, "I don't want to hear this, so I'm rejecting not only what you say but also you, the messenger."

However, here's what we should always remember. Keep the truth as the north star of your life and the bearer of the truth as your friend.
