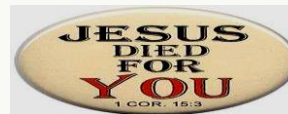

LOOKING IN THE RIGHT DIRECTION

We are mostly familiar with the stories of how Jesus miraculously fed four and five thousand men at different occasions. Well, below is something you just may not have observed from the story.

We limit and cheat ourselves when we are too engrossed with reality or place too much attention on the surrounding situation or look of things around us that we fail to remember that there is a depth out of sight and better direction to look.

This direction is not always around us but upwards as we look up to God.

In Luke 9:10-17, the disciples looked and dwelt so much on the reality of things around them and kept informing Jesus about it but Jesus knew the prevailing situation too but simply refused to dwell on it. He was challenging them to look in the right direction beyond the prevailing situation.

Luke 9: 16 says, "*Jesus took the five loaves and two fish LOOKED UP TOWARDS HEAVEN, and asked God's blessing on the food...*" It is at such times that we appreciate the truth that, "*...with men, this is impossible; but with God all things are possible*" (Matthew 19: 26).

Learn from this experience! It's high time we begin to look in the right direction beyond our situations. David said in Psalm 121: 1-2 – "*I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help. My help cometh from the Lord, which made heaven and earth*".
