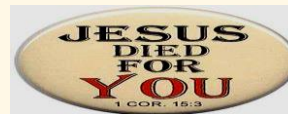

DAVID'S ARMOUR - Os Hillman

"The gifts of a man will make way for him and bring him before great men." – Proverbs 18: 16

But without faith it is impossible to please God – Hebrews 11: 6

David fastened on his sword over the tunic and tried walking around, because he was not used to them. "I cannot go in these," he said to Saul, "because I am not used to them." So he took them off. - 1Samuel 17: 39

David, the young shepherd boy, heard the challenge from the Philistines to send someone to fight Goliath. No one volunteered to fight except David. King Saul reluctantly agreed and offered David his armor. David put on the weighty equipment, but quickly concluded he could not fight in this heavy armor.
