- iv. Hard/harsh words, rebuke and chastisement Jn.6: 60-62, 65-68; Matt.16: 22-23.

II. The Invitation to Follow Jesus:

- 1. The general invitation is for all Matt.11: 28; Jn.3: 16.
- 2. The exclusive choice but only few are chosen Matt.22: 14. Why?
- i. From The Follower's Angle His disposition, interest and preferences will always affect his choice (of who to follow)
- ii. The Leader's Angle His disposition, vision, aims and objectives determines his choice

III. The Benefits & Rewards of Following Jesus:

Nobody does anything if it has no benefits - even smoking

1. Freedom from Satan, sin, sickness, sorrow and shame - Matt.11: 28.

- 2. Unlimited Access to Jesus, His word and blessings Mk.3: 14.
- 3. Representation The ultimate benefit of following a leader is to be like him and to represent him. Imagine Peter eventually on the Day of Pentecost. Pray for your own Day of Pentecost also! Mk.3: 14; Matt.10: 25a.
- 4. Meaningful earthly life Jn.10: 10.
- 5. Ultimate rest and reward in heaven Matt.19: 27-29.

Conclusion:

Jesus is still calling men today - Matt.11: 28-30; Eph.4: 11.
