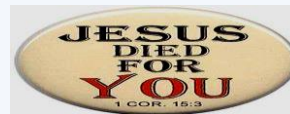

THE MEANING OF EASTER

Easter is the day when we celebrate Jesus Christ rising from the dead! Jesus is the Son of God and heroically gave His life to die for our sins. On the third day after He died -- the day we now celebrate as Easter Sunday -- His friends went to His grave, and found that He had risen from the dead. They saw an angel who told them, "Don't be afraid! I know you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. He isn't here! He has been raised from the dead, just as He said it would happen" (Matt.28: 5-6).

Jesus rose from the dead on Easter Sunday; now He offers to you the gift of eternal life and forgiveness of sins. **This is the true story of Easter, and how it can change your life.** Here are four principles that tell how you can receive the gift of God for your life.

1. God Loves You! - The Bible says, "God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life" (John.3: 16). *But the problem is that*

2. All of us have sinned - This is called sin, and our sins have separated us from God. The Bible says "All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (Romans 3: 23). God is perfect and holy, and our sins separate us from God forever. The Bible says "The wages of sin is death" (Romans 6: 23. *However, the good news is that, about 2,000 years ago...*

3. God sent His only Son Jesus Christ to die on the cross for our sins - Jesus is the Son of God. He lived a sinless life and then died on the cross to pay the penalty for our sins. The Bible says "God demonstrates His own love for us in that while we were yet sinners Christ died for us" (Romans 5: 8). Jesus rose from the dead and now He lives in heaven with God His Father. He now offers us the gift of eternal life -- of living forever with Him in heaven if we accept Him as our Lord and Saviour. Jesus said "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except by Me" (John 14: 6). God reaches out in love to you and wants you to be His child. "As many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe on His name" (John 1: 12). You can choose to ask Jesus Christ to forgive your sins and come in to your life as your Lord and Saviour. You can do so now!

If you want to accept Jesus Christ as your Saviour and Lord, and turn from your sins, you can do so by praying a prayer like this: "Heavenly Father, Thank you for sending Jesus Christ to die on the cross for my sins. Please, forgive my sins, make me your child and give me the gift of eternal life. I believe Jesus is the Son of God and receive Him into my life as my Lord and Saviour. Thank you for answering my prayer in Jesus name. Amen!"
