WHOLE-HEARTEDNESS

God wants wholeheartedness, not half-heartedness. There are many Christians today who would quickly agree that they are presently seeking God and desiring His presence in their life. But if the "whole heart" is not involved, it all becomes unacceptable to the Lord.

Seek Him With The Whole Heart – Psalm 119: 2

Have a sincere desire to know God's will and do it... have no sinister or selfish aims...seek Him by prayer and supplication in sincerity and without hypocrisy, guile, or lukewarmness...seek to know more of Him...in good earnest seek for communion and fellowship with Him...seek a knowledge of Him in order to conform to His will...don't seek self or your own things but Him alone ...desire to see Him glorified in obedience...seek Him with all your powers and energies - all your soul, understanding, will, conscience, and affections ...seek Him supremely, above every other object, diligently, immediately, continually, without delay, earnestly, and with a zealous and undivided heart.

Praise Him With The Whole Heart – Psalm 9: 1

With all of the powers of mind and soul employed, David gave utterance to his feelings of the greatness and adoration of his God in the loftiest and purest manner possible. He openly declared his praises - not with divided affections - not with a heart that was removed and far from God or gone after other objects - not with a divided or half-heart - but with undivided attention - meaning that his will, intellect, and imagination were all actively involved.

Obey Him With The Whole Heart – Psalm 119: 34

With vigor, resolution, pleasure and delight, the Psalmist desired to keep God's law with undivided affection. He didn't trifle with God as so many do today. He didn't divide his affections with the world. He did the will of God from his heart... heartily...as to the Lord...not to men...with sincere affection for Him...and with a single eye to His glory.

Crave For More Of Him With The Whole Heart – Psalm 119: 58

With sincere and undivided affection, the Psalmist longed for God's presence. He earnestly desired to see His face and enjoy His favor or smile. It is not enough to seek God...praise Him...obey His commands...or entreat His favor. He is looking for a people who will give Him a wholehearted service rather than one that is half-hearted. It certainly has to come from the heart in order to reach His heart.
