

GIVE UP TO GO UP

We already know that giving is a major door to divine visitation but giving requires faith. Givers are men and women of faith because giving is God's sole prescription for a life of faith. Those who give demonstrate that they have surrendered their lives and handed over their future to God and so trust Him to provide for them and meet their needs.

Giving is a major way to demonstrate our faith in God that He will visit us to meet our needs and not abandon or forsake us as He has promised in Heb.13: 5. Without this type of faith for the future, giving becomes difficult if not practically impossible. For us to give out what we presently have or possess, we must be able to trust that God will replace it or even give us more – be it money, materials, energy, time or talent. This is where the challenge lies in giving!

Most men don't have this type of faith and that then explains the general attitude or tendency to amass, hoard and withhold unnecessarily in order to make provision for the future. The only hindrance to giving therefore is fear while the propelling force to giving is faith but as Christians, we have no choice really but to learn to live by faith (Hab.2: 4; Rom.1: 17; Gal.3: 11; Heb.10: 38).

All givers in the Bible were people of faith who overcame their fears and trusted God to provide for them in the future. Conversely, all bad givers in the Bible were anxious and worried people who could not overcome their fears and so lacked the faith to trust that God would provide for their future. Usually, the general principle is, the more our faith, the more we shall be willing to give but the more our fears, the more we shall withhold and find it difficult to give.

Abraham demonstrated his faith in God through giving. We should do the same also. It is ironic that many today who want to be blessed like Abraham don't want to give like him. The Rich Young Ruler wanted to end up in Abraham's bosom like Lazarus but he was not willing to give up like Abraham. He held so tightly to his earthly riches and lost out of the Kingdom of God. We must learn from him!
