



WRITING YOUR ACTS WITH YOUR LIFE

There's a book in the Bible called "The Acts of the Apostles." It's full of the stories of the exploits of the great men and women in the Early Church who took over immediately after the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Notable among them are: Stephen, Phillip, Paul, Peter, James and John. Peter and Paul no doubt were most outstanding.

You can't just be indifferent to the Book of Acts especially comparing the Church then and now. One could not but ask: Why were they so successful? How did they do it? What led to their astounding success? Two factors stand them out especially studying the lives of Peter and Paul.

1. Genuine Repentance and a Complete Turn-around.

Repentance involves deep regret and being sorry for sin; developing Godly sorrow as stated in 2Cor.7: 10. It is total renunciation of sin and not just mere reformation. Although Peter betrayed and denied Christ shortly before His crucifixion yet he became remorseful and wept bitterly for his lapse. Christ Himself helped restore him after He rose from death when He asked him three times whether he loved Him more than fish or not. Peter reaffirmed his faith and love for Christ all over again.

Paul also encountered Christ on the road to Damascus while going to persecute the Christians in his misplaced zeal. He was immediately convicted of his error, became thoroughly repentant and from that moment turned around to serve the Living Lord. He was never the same thereafter. Too many Christians today are too casual, care-free and nonchalant with sin.

2. The Power and Help of the Holy Spirit.

These men worked in partnership with the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit helped them in several ways but notably in the following ways to –

- Start very well. Don't forget that foundation matters in everything in life (Acts 9: 26-31).
- Live life with passion. They were vibrant and exciting (Acts 5: 17-42). Too many believers today are living dull and unenviable lives.
- Worship through trials (Acts 16: 16-34). Suffering couldn't get them down or away from worshipping God.
- iv. Live their faith. They had both faith and works. They put their faith to task and produced tangible fruits and results for all to see (Acts 26: 32; 27: 44).
- v. Be focused and keep proper perspective to the end (2Tim.4: 7-8). They were not distracted by worldly amusements, cheers of men or the jeers of the enemies.

Let us emulate them at least starting from now onwards.
