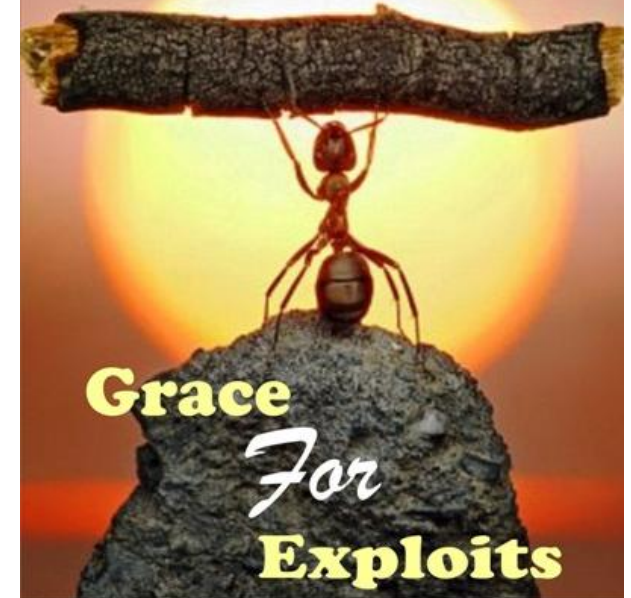

## SOARING HIGH - Isaiah 40: 29-31

A Christian is expected to be like the eagle – Unlike other birds that merely fly, the eagle mounts up with wings to great heights and soar by riding on top of the wind. The eagle then is not afraid of storms or contrary winds.

Life is full of many storms that we must learn to confront and not shy away from. We must not be afraid of difficulties and challenges in life but trust God to mount up by the help of the Holy Spirit to ride over every contrary situation and circumstance.

Mounting is like a woman carrying a baby on her back or a surfer riding the sea wave. Mounting up requires some efforts from us at first, after which God then takes over. The truth is – all is not totally dependent on us as it is not also totally dependent on God. Here lies the mystery of our divine partnership and cooperation with God – **1Cor.3: 9**. And there is need for good balance here.

Soaring does not require as much energy or power as flying just as surfing does not require as much power as swimming. The wind sustains the soaring eagle in the air just as the sea wave sustains the surfer in surfing. As Christians, we must depend on the Holy Spirit in every way – **Prov.3: 5-6; Zech.4: 6; Jn.15: 5** Mounting up requires faith; we mount up on the wings of faith – **Heb.10: 38 (Hab.2: 4; Rom.1: 17; Gal.3: 11); Heb.11: 6, 1; Phil.4: 6; Matt.6: 25-32; Lk.12: 24-30**

Like Joseph, we have no excuse for failing in life – **Prov.24: 10; Rom.8: 31** Joseph did not use his problems as excuses for failure. He did not allow all that happened to him to get him down. He recovered and kept mounting up each time. God wants each of His children to be like that. Don't allow whatever happens to you get you down.

No one will live your life for you. Just as the eagle must learn how to mount up with wings and ride the wind, every born-again and Spirit-filled Christian must learn how to ride on the situation and circumstances of life by the power of the Holy Spirit.

The eagle does not struggle. We also must not struggle through life but learn how to make use of God's anointing in every situation we find ourselves. The anointing is God's oil that makes the engines of our lives run smoothly without friction, noise, heat or smoke. The anointing is God's unction to function. It is the power of the Holy Spirit at work in our lives to fulfill God's purpose (not our own purpose or agenda) in life.
