




TASTE AND SEE

The University of Chicago, Divinity School one year on a "Baptist Day" invited Dr. Paul Tillich, one of the greatest minds to lecture in the Theological Education Center. Dr. Tillich spoke for two and a half hours "proving" that the resurrection of Jesus was false. He quoted scholar after scholar and book after book. He concluded that since there was no such thing as the historical resurrection, the religious tradition of the church was groundless and an emotional mumbo-jumbo because it was based on a relationship with a risen Jesus, who, in fact, never rose from the dead in any literal sense. He then asked if there were any questions.

After about 30 seconds, an old, dark skinned preacher with a head of short-cropped, woolly white hair stood up in the back of the auditorium.

"Doctor Tillich, I have one question," he said as all eyes turned toward him. He reached into his lunch sack and pulled out an apple and began eating it. "Tillich"... CRUNCH, MUNCH... "My question is simple," ... CRUNCH, MUNCH. "Now, I've never read those books you read..." CRUNCH, MUNCH "... and I can't recite the Scriptures in the original Greek"... CRUNCH, MUNCH..." I don't know anything about the authorities you cited"... CRUNCH, MUNCH... He finished the apple. "But all I want to know is: This apple I just ate... was it bitter or sweet?"

Dr. Tillich paused for a moment and answered in exemplary scholarly fashion: "I cannot possibly answer that question, for I haven't tasted your apple."

The white-haired preacher dropped the core of his apple into his crumpled paper bag, looked up at Dr. Tillich and said calmly, "Neither have you tasted my Jesus."

The 1,000 plus in attendance could not contain themselves. The auditorium erupted with applause and cheers. Dr. Tillich thanked his audience and promptly left the platform. Have you tasted Jesus?
