Have you seen water turned to wine; Witnessed demons cast into swine; Young girls raised now from the dead, A mother cured ... on her death bed.


Have you seen Him walk on water, Feed nine thousand and not falter, Stopping a storm with one raised hand, Restoring sight with spit and sand,
