




FAITH. WORKS OR BOTH

"Yea, a man may say, thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works."

- James 2:18

Christianity is separated from other major religions by this biblical truth: There is nothing man can do to earn the favour of God. Salvation in other religions is dependent on the good works of man to please the deity, or to ensure one's favoured place in the cosmic scheme of things. Only Christianity sets man's good works aside and focuses salvation on the grace of God. Even with that biblical clarity, some Christians still get confused about the place of good works.

It is best understood this way: Christians are not saved by good works, but they are saved for good works. Ephesians 2:8-10 could not be clearer: "For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast. For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them."

We are saved by grace alone through faith in order to accomplish the good works for which God saved us. Our ongoing works, carried out for God, become a sign and testimony of the reality of our salvation. A person saved by grace stops working for self and begins working for God. Christ's work on the cross removed any necessity of our works for salvation. Our works are an expression of gratitude for His.

Anyone can devise a plan by which good people go to heaven but only God can devise a plan whereby sinners, which are His enemies, can go to heaven.
