




WHY GOD BLESSES

There are different keys for different doors; you need the right key to be a blessing. There is a key for every redemptive benefit in Christ. God gave the reason why He would bless us when He talked to Abraham in Genesis 12: 1-3. He said, "And Now the Lord had said to Abram: "Get out of your country, from your family and from your father's house, to a land that I will show you. I will make you a great nation; I will bless you and make your name great; and you shall be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse him who curses you; and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

Many have failed in this regard, thinking God's blessings are for lavish pampering of self only. Many think their good job is a result of their ability and skill. They forget that many better-qualified people out there don't even have the opportunities they have. Your readiness to share God's blessings in your life is the spiritual catalyst that maintains the flow. When you become God's channel of blessing indeed to your world, He will keep the flow of your supply.

What you keep does not guarantee your future; it is what you give that does. The future of Abraham was tied to the release of Isaac. The size of your Bank account does not impress God, your giving and release does. Kingdom wealth is not acquired; it is entrusted by God into the hands of genuine givers. Again, it is not just giving, but its size or level; giving at the rate of God's blessing in our lives. As it is in accounting your in-flow must match your out-flow. The larger your heart is to bless others, the larger the flow of God's blessing towards you.
