WORRY OR REST

Wash the dishes, take out the trash, finish an email—Amanda had more to do in life than there were hours left to do them. She tried to fall asleep, but sleep just wouldn't come. Her financial situation also weighed heavily on her mind. She had lost her job, and money was tight. The load of it all threatened to crush her. Amanda got up and tiptoed to the edge of the nursery where her baby brother slept sweetly. Baby Jeremy didn't feel any of the pressure she did. He didn't know what tomorrow held - he just knew his parents would take care of him.
