THE RUNNER MUST BE FOCUSED

"But without faith it is impossible to please Him: for he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and that He is a Rewarder of them that diligently seek Him." - Heb.11: 6

In a race, the runner has a goal-- an aim to which he is striving for - and he must stay focused on reaching that goal. If he were to start looking all around in every direction as he was running, he would lose pace and might even lose his balance and stumble. We, as Christians, should not be looking all around us but rather should focus our attention upon the Lord Jesus Christ. We must stay focused and keep our eyes upon Jesus. He is our reward. The Lord said to Abraham in Genesis 15:1: After these things the word of the LORD came unto Abram in a vision, saying, Fear not, Abram: I am thy shield, and thy exceeding great reward.
