



THY KINGDOM COME

It's a New Year; A year that will bring joy and sadness, laughter and tears, good and bad times for different people. Will it also mark the year that Christ will return? No one knows, because Jesus said: "Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour in which the Son of Man is coming." (Matt.25: 13 NKJV). But what if 2023 is to be the year of our Lord's return? Would you be excited, ecstatic, or jubilant? Or would you be afraid, sad, or disappointed?

When you pray the Lord's Prayer, try not to just repeat memorized lines, but try to really pray this beautiful prayer meaningfully. It's really a rewarding experience for every serious Christian! Consider the line, "Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done." As we each take a moment to meditate on this line, it will be apparent that many Christians don't really look forward to the Lord's coming again. If we do, I mean, if we TRULY do, then why are so many Christians afraid of death? Why do so many of us say, "Even so, come Lord Jesus – but after I've done this and that." If we truly look forward to Jesus' 2nd coming, shouldn't we be counting the days with great anticipation? What's wrong with us? Why aren't we really looking for Jesus to come? Do we lack faith? Are we too comfortable? Are we simply too complacent?

Imagine a dream trip with only few hints – that the country is several time zones away with large native population; a place with mountains, beaches, and just about everything. The other facts reveal that the trip to this mysterious place will not be fun. The flight will be in two stages with cramped up legs in an airplane for hours and unpleasant rush through airports with heavy luggage, and stress on arrival finding a taxi to take you to your hotel. Should that worry anybody? The truth is the slight discomfort on an airplane is nothing compared to the rich experience on arrival at your destination; the fun far out-ways the little travel discomfort.

This trip is very much like Jesus' 2nd coming. We're not told when it will be. We're not even given a clear picture of what, exactly, is going to happen. We're just given little "snippets" of information. Should we be worried about this? We can trust our Heavenly Father, who formed our bodies and ordained our days while in the womb (Ps.139: 16), to make what comes after our earthly life so special that we wouldn't ever want to turn back. And what about death for those who die in Christ before rapture? Like a plane ride, the time spent travelling will be so special that the travel unpleasantness will be well worthwhile. Same with the end of life! Death, like travelling is a necessary step to arriving at the beautiful eternal life God planned for us when He returns. It may be tough to get through, but we don't need to fear it, for, it is but a means to a very beautiful end!
