KING OF STORMS - JESUS

A pastor had been on a long flight between New York to Texas for Church conferences. The first warning of the approaching problems came when the sign on the airplane flashed on: Fasten Your Seat Belts. Then, after a while, a calm voice said, We shall not be serving the meal at this time as we are expecting a little turbulence. Please be sure your seat belt is fastened. As the pastor looked around the aircraft, it became obvious that many of the passengers were becoming apprehensive.
