BALANCED DIET

Dear Preachers - When you preach the correct biblical principle of sowing and reaping, please, balance it with the biblical principle of hard work, diligence, industry and creativity (like Joseph, Ruth, Daniel, etc) or else you will be raising a bunch of lazy Christians always expecting manna from heaven.

When you preach the correct biblical principle of perfect and divine health, please balance it with the correct biblical principle of healthy living, or else you will be raising a bunch of gluttonous Christians that will be casting the spirit of high cholesterol out of obviously harmful meals.

When you preach the principle of transfer of the Gentiles' wealth, please, balance it with the teaching of hard work, solid business ethics, fiscal discipline, developing a competitive edge within an industry and the importance of planning (who amongst you will want to build a house and not first of all count the cost (Luke 14: 28-30)?

When you teach them that God will prosper them, please, let them know that it is what their hands find to do that God will bless and multiply. God will not bless or multiply an empty or idle hand which does nothing.

Please, teach them that God did not say He would give them wealth. The Bible says it is God that gives you power to make wealth (Deuteronomy 8: 18). Tell them God will give them power in form of knowledge, intellect, talents, skills, good health, time, friends, and God expects them to use this power to make wealth.

When you preach that God will bring knowledge to the remembrance of students writing exams, please, balance it with the fact that it is what they have studied beforehand that can be remembered. Teach them to study hard for their exams. The Apostle Paul specifically requested Timothy to bring his BOOKS to him in the prison (2 Timothy 4: 13).

When you teach them that none shall lack their mate, please, teach them also interpersonal relationship skills, a positive attitude, modest dressing and social etiquette.

Please, teach them the correct things; not mere presumptions for the Body of Christ to be healthy and vibrant. May the LORD help His Church! Amen.
