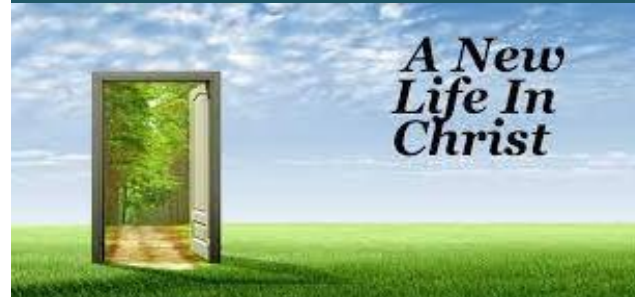

GOD WILL GIVE YOU A NEW NAME

Like Peter, Jesus sees in you what you can be - regardless of what you are presently. God knows what we are and loves us all the same, but He loves us enough not to leave us that way (Philippians 1: 6).
