THE POWER OF SOLITUDE

"In the early morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house, and went away to a secluded place, and was praying there" - Mark 1: 35.

Morning was the only time Jesus could be alone. The next verses say they hunted for Him even then and when they found Him said, "Everyone is looking for You" (Mark.1: 36-37). Jesus needed the solitude of that early morning talk with His Father to filter things out - and, so do we.

Solitude is good for us. Our natural tendency is to always have people around, always have stuff going on, but candidly, I've never learned anything all that significant in a crowd. I love to be with people, but solitude helps filter out the essentials away from the non-essentials. Life kind of makes up its mind in solitude.

If the truth were known, some of you live on the ragged edge because you continually deal with people, demands, expectations, children pulling at you, friends, schedules, and plans. You can't remember the last time you spent absolutely alone...

Sometimes it's a long lone walk. But I'll tell you, every time it happens, it's deliberate. No one has ever said to me, "You need to get alone for a while." No, this is a choice we all have to make. But some might be wondering, "What do I do when I'm alone?"

I have found that one of the best uses of my time in solitude is keeping a note or journal. - a record of experiences, ideas, or reflections kept regularly for private use. I want you to consider keeping one too. You'll find it keeps you from losing the best things you gain in your solitude, and that's what draws you closer to the heart of God.

You owe it to God, you owe it to yourself, and you owe it to those you love the most to make solitude a deliberate choice in your life. It'll take an adjustment to your schedule, but it will make a meaningful difference in your life.
