

THERE IS HOPE

"For there is hope of a tree, if it be cut down, that it will sprout again, and that the tender branch thereof will not cease. Though the root thereof wax old in the earth, and the stock thereof die in the ground; yet through the scent of water it will bud, and bring forth boughs like a plant." - Job 14: 7-9.

Life is full of ups and downs, failures and successes, triumphs and defeats. Many times, we are bashed as it were from all spheres of life and at such times, if care is not taken, we despair. The future looks bleak and all that is in the immediate focus gives no encouragement at all. Does this describe your situation totally or partially? Have you lost the push or drive to start all over again for fear of failure? Have you lost your faith and confidence?

I can understand how you feel and the Lord Jesus Christ does much more. He sees every little tear drop that falls from your eyes. He knows every heartache and sigh. He understands everything you are passing through and He really, really cares for you. In the midst of your despair, He wants to give you fresh and new hope but there is no way He can do it if you don't believe and cooperate with Him. Try to brighten up and see what good God can make out of your situation. If you are thinking "there is nothing to start with all over again". That certainly is not true.

Don't focus on the odds or factors against you. They would be of no help. In fact, such would increase the worthlessness of your situation and make another effort or trial difficult. Instead, be calm, cool and collected. Try and itemise the assets and values you have left. Really, they could be small but like the Song Writer said, "Little becomes much when we place it in the Master's hands." Zero in on the areas of your interest – business, marriage, career, children, etc.

- 1. Top on your list of assets to encourage another trial is God Himself. One with God is a majority. (Isaiah 43: 1-7, Romans 8: 28 & 32).
- 2. Look around for fellow Christians who could be of help and share your problems with them. You would be amazed at what you can benefit from others (Proverbs 27: 17).
- 3. Like Apostle Paul, say to yourself repeatedly, I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me (Philippians 4: 13).

You certainly can make a success of that failing situation you are in right now by the help of the Lord. Finally, be alert and sensitive in your spirit for God's guidance. He would lead and bring you to feed in His green pastures. He would restore your hope again!
