NEW YEAR PERSPECTIVE

New Beginnings: Start out the New Year with a fresh point of view to new experiences, memories and blessings. Having an opened mind and heart to whatever the Lord may bring your way and wherever He may take you with full assurance and confidence that He is with you (Matthew 28:19-20).
